- **Place Highlight:** **STONEHENGE** is the heart of many of the activities in Senior Camp. It serves as the place where Senior Legend has morning and afternoon meetings. It is also where the first-day orientation and end-of-session awards ceremonies for all of Senior Camp (Quest and Legend) happen. In the center of Stonehenge is the Knighthood Circle. At the end of the awards ceremony, a camper who has achieved the overall level of Knight enters this circle and pulls out the sword, Excalibur, from the stones. Pictured below are Stonehenge as it looked in the 1990's, the knighting of the first ever knight, Kat Pebworth, in 1982, and today's knight Thomas, the second camper to achieve Knighthood this year. We are super proud of Thomas for his hard work and dedication to reaching this point.


